






Horizontal pole mounted in front of a vertical pole.


Can be mounted anywhere along the vertical pole. This is an alternative to configuration 'C'. It can also be mounted back to back as an alternative to configuration 'D'.










Any collar compatible B-Tech mount (indicated in the new mounts catalogue with the symbol shown below), can be attached to a pole structure created with the BT7025. Examples of 2 typical installations are shown above.

Selecting the right collar.

These example configurations use the B-Tech 50mm System 2 range of poles and collars. It is however possible to also use the BT7025 in conjunction with the 60mm professional range of B-Tech mounts.

Thick collars can be used where thin collars are shown but collar covers cannot always be used (depending on configuration).
